

BC Calculus - The Final Three Weeks

- You, as the student, will work individually or as a group of not more than 4, and complete a project.
- Your project may be but not limited to a music video, instructional guide, song, song parody, short movie, short story, poem, children's book, reality show, contest, etc.
- Your project will cover some topic(s) in BC Calculus or specific problem(s) in BC Calculus. There must be specific Calculus knowledge demonstrated.
- The Calculus must be relevant to the theme, topic, or problem and should be correct.
- Your final project will be submitted on or before May 25th
- All projects must be Creative, Correct, and Clean. Do not be inappropriate.
- There will be 2 dates (May 13th/May 20th) at which you will have to display to me progress on your project.
 - Project ideas and outline
 - What is everyone doing
 - What has everyone done
 - Calculus completed
 - Written script
- All project grades will be a 94% (A) if all of the above is followed. Failure to work on project in class will be cause for point deductions.
- Students wishing for additional points should be extremely creative in their project
- Students can also present their project for additional points. There are limited spots and will be on a first come, first serve basis.
